



### **Network Map from Great Streets Plan**





### Proposed Empire Street layout (Fountain to Broad): One car lane each direction; keep on-street parking on both sides of the street; urban trail on southwest side




### Proposed Chestnut Street

**layout** (Broad to Clifford): One car lane each direction; no on-street parking; urban trail on southwest side (between Weybosset and Pine, the street will remain one-way for cars as it is today)

### **Empire St & Chestnut St**

Adding a two-way separated urban trail on southbound side



### 15 parking spaces added

- Claverick: 17 new
- Friendship: 37 new
- Chestnut: removing 32
- Richmond: removing 7



### **Richmond St**

Half-block connection from Clifford Street to West Side Park via Elbow Street alongside Point225







### **George M Cohan Path**

Clarifying shared use of existing path around Parcel 9. Connection to South Water Street path following completion of Parcel 6 construction.
