New site on west side of park

In 2024, the Providence Flea outdoor summer markets will be located on the west side of District Park located at 120 Peck Street in downtown Providence. The summer Flea's Opening Day is Sunday, June 2, from 10 am - 3 pm, and the market will continue to run every Sunday in District Park through September 15.
