Re: Report on the 1-195 Redevelopment Project Fund for Fiscal Year 2025

Dear Speaker Shekarchi, Senate President Lawson, and Secretary Pryor:

We are pleased to submit this I-195 Redevelopment Project Fund (Fund) Fiscal Year 2025 report. The I-195 Redevelopment District (District) has continued to experience a significant amount of activity through Fiscal Year 2025. As of June 30, 2025, the District has sold 8.34 acres of the approximately 20 acres of developable land. Currently, three projects are under construction: the second phase of the mixed-use, mixed-income project on Parcel 9, which broke ground in December 2024; 150 Richmond, a 200,000-SF commercial lab development that is anchored by the Rhode Island State Health Lab and the Ocean State Labs incubator is expected to be complete this fall; and the District is constructing a freestanding pavilion to serve 195 District Park that will include food and beverage services, support space for park operations, and public restrooms in addition to infrastructure upgrades such as WiFi, drainage improvements, and enhanced electrical service. The Michael S. Van Leesten Pedestrian Bridge remains a major attraction since its opening, and 195 District Park is on track to host over 330 events and over 1.8 million visits in 2025. Finally, there are several projects in various stages of pre-development in the District. These projects and the success of the six completed projects are contributing to the District's continued momentum.

As detailed in the attached table, nearly \$24 million of the approximately \$28 million committed from the Fund, has been disbursed. The unspent funds are deposited in a Santander collateralized money market account. The I-195 Redevelopment District submits this information pursuant to the statutory provisions that direct the I-195 Redevelopment District to report this program's fiscal year activity.
